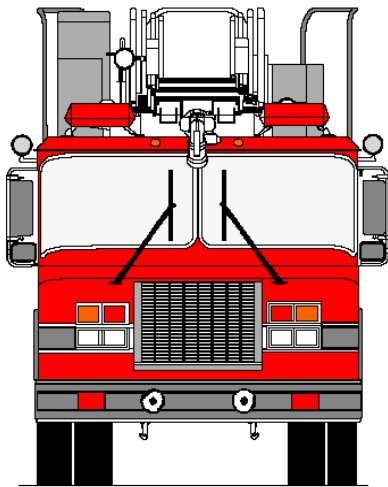

CLASS INFORMATION

FIRE PUMPS & ACCESSORIES

This class will acquaint students with the principles and theories associated with the maintenance, pump operation, and operational pump testing required for fire apparatus and equipment. This class fulfills partial education requirement for Fire Mechanic Level I state certification.

Required Materials: Protective Clothing; i.e., boots, gloves, helmet, hearing protection

Additional State Test Fee of \$80.00 required at the time of registration

AERIAL APPARATUS

This class will cover the physical principles of manufacture, testing and preventative maintenance of aerial devices commonly found in use by the fire service.. This class fulfills partial education requirement for Fire Mechanic Level III certification.

Required Materials: Calculator, highlighter, coveralls and work boots.

Additional State Test Fee of \$80.00 required at the time of registration

BASIC ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS

This is the first of two courses in the electrical certification series. This course is designed for the student with little or no knowledge of electrical systems as they relate to automotive and truck applications and is **REQUIRED** for students wishing to take the electrical certification class and state examination. This class will cover electrical theory, magnetism, semi-conductors, transistors, re-lays, circuit theory, circuit building and testing, multi-meter basics, charging systems and wiring diagrams and schematics.
