CLASS INFORMATION

FIRE PUMPS & ACCESSORIES

This class will acquaint students with the principles and theories associated with the maintenance, pump operation, and operational pump testing required for fire apparatus and equipment. This class fulfills partial education requirement for Fire Mechanic Level I state certification. The class is a total of 36 hours, 8 hours each on Monday through Thursday (8:00 am–5:00 pm) and concludes at noon on Friday.

Required Materials: Protective Clothing; i.e., boots, gloves, helmet, hearing protection

Additional State Fire Training Class Fee of \$80.00 required at the time of registration

ALLISON TRANSMISSIONS

This class will cover a thorough introduction, application and general assembly of the Allison transmission. Training includes a complete transmission teardown and rebuild, subassembly tear down, hydraulics, power flows, troubleshooting, parts and maintenance procedures. This class fulfills partial education requirements for Fire Mechanic Level II state certification. The class is a total of 36 hours, 8 hours each on Monday through Thursday and concluding at noon on Friday. BASIC ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS

This is the first of two courses in the electrical certification series. This course is designed for the student with little or no knowledge of electrical systems as they relate to automotive and truck applications and is **REQUIRED** for students wishing to take the electrical certification class and state examination. This class will cover electrical theory, magnetism, semi-conductors, transistors, relays, circuit theory, circuit building and testing, multi-meter basics, charging systems and wiring diagrams and schematics. The class is a total of 36 hours, 8 hours each on Monday through Thursday and concluding at noon on Friday. The class is a total of 32 hours, 8 hours each on Monday through Thursday, 8:00 am–5:00 pm.

GENERAL INFORMATION
